Held in the playing fields of de Stafford School in Burntwood Lane, Caterham, Day One featured local rock bands and solo artists that drew a large audience of youngsters, many of them friends and supporters of the up and coming musicians.

Day Two kicked off with the Classic Car Cruise with the large convoy of vintage and military vehicles drawing lots of attention as it wound its way round Caterham. On their return to de Stafford School, the vehicles parked up in the playing field so they could be admired by the crowds attending DeFest.

Music from the '40s and '50s was the theme on Day Two with local swing singer John Lazenby accompanied by Jenny Green performing some popular numbers such as 'New York, New York' to bring the weekend to a

close. During the course of the weekend the audience were also treated to other attractions including sideshows, a bouncy castle, a Pimms tent run by Caterham Rotary Club, a display by Zodiac Gym Club and a birds of prey exhibition.

After the event the chief organiser, Mark Jones, said: "After two wet DeFests, our perseverance paid off! It's been a fabulous weekend and I would like to thank everyone who gave us their support. It is thanks to them that we are able to put on this event to give a platform for local musicians and an event for the local community to enjoy."

Club devastated at second pavilion fire in eight years

Surrey Police have not yet arrested anyone in connection with the arson attack on a brand new cricket pavilion in Caterham-on-the-Hill on Saturday, 12th May. The incident took place at around 11pm at the newly built complex on Park Avenue.

Officers would like to trace four children who were seen acting suspiciously in the area earlier the same day. They included three boys, one who was wearing a burgundy hoody and a girl who was wearing a peach top and has long blonde hair.

The fire has devastated the members of Caterham Cricket Club, who were looking forward to the opening of the new pavilion the following weekend.

Colin Mico, a member of Caterham CC said: "We are starting to feel slightly victimised. In 2004 we got burnt out of the pavilion in Queen's Park and lost everything and were kindly taken in by the Old Cats Rugby Club in Park Road. Caterham School very kindly stepped in and said they would pay for the new pavilion because they needed changing facilities for the lacrosse players.

"Despite the fire we want everyone to know that we are alive and kicking and continuing to do things for the local community. We have spent a lot of money upgrading the facilities and would love people who are interested in cricket to come along to meet us at training on Friday evenings." Group celebrates official transfer of ownership of the Soper Hall to the community

Friday 25th May saw Tandridge District Council transfer ownership of the Soper Hall in Caterham to the Soper Hall Community Centre Limited (SHCCL) to develop and run the building as a community facility. The group is now the freehold owner. It is a registered charity, with a business plan to refurbish the building and significantly increase community use of the site.

The District Council was keen to support the local running and control of the hall, as part of the government's localism agenda and believes this will revitalise the hall, making it a focal point for Caterham residents.

Tandridge District Council has agreed to provide up to £100,000 matched funding over two years to help with the transfer and on the understanding the Caterham and Warlingham Citizens Advice Bureau, Tandridge Voluntary Service Council

and Lions Talking Newspaper will continue to be based at the building.

Leader of the Council, Councillor Gordon Keymer, said: "We feel this transfer secures the future of Soper Hall for the benefit of the community and we wish the group every success with its plans for the building."

Chairman of SHCCL, Graham Tapley, said: "We are delighted that the legal formalities have been completed today and look forward to the challenges that lie ahead. We would like to thank Tandridge District Council for its vote of confidence in our Community Company and for providing the essential framework for the successful asset transfer. We are especially grateful to the officers for their diligence during the transfer process and particularly wish to thank the Leader of the Council, Councillor Keymer for his support and involvement in the project."

Internet alerts thousands to the threat to iconic showroom

In late April Churchill Retirement Homes submitted a planning application to Tandridge District Council for a development of 35 sheltered apartments and retail premises on the land currently occupied by the Caterham Cars showroom in Station Avenue, Caterham. The deadline for sending comments to the council on the controversial application was Friday 11th May. As the local press did not have enough time to publish the news well in advance of the deadline, the word was spread using the internet, including an item in the Email newsletter sent out by The Caterham and District Independent seven days before the deadline and two 'Save Caterham Cars' Facebook pages. Within a few hours the Caterham Independent story had received over 3,000 hits and thanks to the internet, support for Caterham Cars rallied and over 200 objections had been sent to the council by the deadline of 11th May.

In the Caterham Independent article, Chris Windridge, Chairman of the Caterham Community Partnership, said: "We have to show the Planning Department at Tandridge District Council the strength of feeling for keeping the Caterham Cars showroom in Caterham Between us we have thousands of contacts that we must call on for support immediately." Andy Noble, Sales and Marketing

Director at Caterham Cars, said: "There is a common misconception that we have decided to move out of Caterham but that is not the case. If we are not offered an extension or renewal of the leasehold by the owners of the land we will be forced to move elsewhere. We would love to stay here."

In a statement from Churchill Retirement Homes, MD, Andrew Burgess said: "The existing use of the site is clearly an unsuitably located land use in the town centre and conflicts with the aims and objectives of Policies SS1, SH1 and CSP23 which seek to enhance the vitality of Caterham town centre. With this in mind, the proposed development for a mix of commercial uses and sheltered housing in this central location is acceptable in principle and meets the requirements of local and national planning policy."

Tandridge District Council are due to make a decision on the application in June.

The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 - Publicity under Regulation 6

Tandridge District Council has received an application under Regulation 5 to designate a neighbourhood area for the purposes of creating a Neighbourhood Plan.

The groups seeking to act together to carry out a plan, include: Caterham Hill Parish Council (who will act as the primary parish), Caterham Valley Parish Council, Chaldon Village Council and Whyteleafe Village Council, The Caterham Community Partnership Ltd, The Caterham Business Partnership plus others who will be invited to participate.

The proposal is more completely described in the document submitted jointly with Tandridge District Council, to the Department for Communities and Local Government last year and which resulted in the selection of the bid for funds under the "Front Runner" scheme, the bid document is available at: www.tandridge.gov.uk/neighbourhoodplanning



The groups consider that the primary parish, Caterham Hill Parish Council, is a relevant body under Section 61G of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and to be responsible for the creation of a Neighbourhood Plan. 

Diary of a Plantaholic

by Sue Baines

I guess every gardening year is a challenge, as no two seasons are ever the same, and that certainly applies this year. Copious amounts of rain have brought the garden to life dramatically. Everything is lush, and floppy. Luckily I had started to support plants during the warmer, drier, spells in March, never dreaming we would have so much rain. These supports are home-made of chicken wire, taken off a reel. We have made them small, medium and large with a diameter of two feet, but they could be cut to any size you like. They are a bit fiddly to make and with the canes (plus caps) are visible for several months. On the plus side they don't seem to deteriorate, are very effective, and (long-term), cheap. With the Chelsea Flower Show comes the reminder of the 'Chelsea Chop'. In



gardening, timing is everything, and late May is the ideal time, so that is the reason for its name. It is the time for me to cut back part of my established clumps, which is successful with Phlox and Campanula, taking about half the stems down to half size and doing it sympathetically to leave it looking as natural as possible. The original stems will flower at the same time as usual, but the cut back ones will be delayed, coming out as the first are over (hopefully). Border sedums are slightly different, although the timing is the same. Cut them all in half, poking the cut pieces in next to the main clump. They will grow more sturdily, but should flower OK as long as I do it as soon as possible.

Local Walks - Kenley Common and Riddlesdown

Kenley Common and Riddlesdown are excellent walking terrains. The airfield's crucial role on Kenley Common during World War Two is legendary. The commemorative panels, placed at various parts of the airfield, are well worth reading for they inform walkers about the airfield's history. But take care to adhere to the warning signs about the present-day gliders!

It is worth exploring the woods to the north of the airfield. The total number of miles for this easy, level, circular walk is about two. There is car parking on Hayes Lane, Kenley outside the airfield. Alternatively you can walk to Kenley Common via Hillcrest Road in Whyteleafe. Refreshments can be obtained at the Wattenden Arms in nearby Old Lodge Lane, reputed to have been a favourite with airmen and containing pictures and artefacts associated with the airfield.

Riddlesdown, adjacent to the A22 at Kenley, has a track along the hill top and parts follow a Roman road

which once connected London with the south coast. The track passes a disused chalk quarry which is a nature reserve and SSSI (Site of Special Scientific Interest). Along the grassy track there are splendid panoramic views, and on fine days skylarks sing above fields full of grasses and wild flowers. The track is less than two miles long. To access, a car park is situated south of Riddlesdown Road in Purley and there are local trains and buses. If you are feeling energetic, you could add an extra mile to the Riddlesdown walk by starting from Whyteleafe Recreation Ground in Hillbury Road. The recreation ground has a good-sized car park and The Whyteleafe Tavern pub nearby for refreshments before or after the walk.

Eating Out

Good food and a warm welcome at Il Carretto

If you like good Italian food with a little bit of friendly banter thrown in for good measure, then Il Carretto Restaurant and Pizzeria in Coulsdon is just the place.

I visited the restaurant with my friend Geraint recently and we were soon chuckling at the restaurant owner Andrea and his waiter, Tony, addressing each other as 'Grandad' and 'Uncle'! As Geraint commented, a friendly host and good ambience makes all the difference to the experience of dining out. Of course the food matters too, and the menu had an excellent choice of traditional pizza and pasta dishes starting at just £6.95. There are also meat, fish and vegetarian choices - something for everyone!

We wanted some white wine to go with the meal so Andrea recommended a bottle of Frascati, a crisp, fruity wine which was perfect for a warm evening.

For our starters, I chose 'Cozze della Casa', mussels cooked with white wine, tomato sauce, garlic and a touch of chilli (pictured right) and Geraint chose 'Parmigiana', layers of aubergine oven baked with mozzarella, parmesan and tomato sauce. Both starters were served lovely and hot, and I really enjoyed the flavour of the mussels cooked the Italian way.

Geraint described his starter as 'fulsome', with so many delicious ingredients!

I chose one of the meat dishes, the 'Agnello al Balsamico', leg of lamb cooked with rosemary and balsamic jus (pictured right) for my main course and Geraint chose the 'Filetto', fillet steak served with a red wine and dolcelate sauce.

Our food was beautifully cooked, with tender meat and perfect 'al dente' vegetables. The servings were generous with plenty of vegetables so we did not need any extra side orders.

Although by now I was pretty full, the 'Special' dessert, Tiramisu, sounded very tempting. A traditional Italian recipe consisting of whipped layers of egg yolks and Marscapone cheese it
